LEARN GERMAN AT THE PROTESTANT UNIVERSITY OF RWANDA (PUR)

Prepare for Training as a Care Worker in Germany and Working with German Partners

The Protestant University of Rwanda (PUR), in collaboration with *Stadtmission Nürnberg e.V.* (Germany), is calling for applications to the German language program aimed at preparing individuals for professional training as care workers in Germany. This initiative also offers opportunities to collaborate with German partners in Rwanda and the Great Lakes Region, and pursue a career in professional care.

I. Mode of attendance

This is a full-time program and includes:

- **4 hours of classroom instruction**
- **3 hours of self-study**
- **Monday to Friday**

Selected candidates will receive a scholarship covering:

- Tuition fees
- Study materials
- Examination fees

However, they will be required to pay a contribution of **RWF 150,000 for the entire duration of the program** toward the cost of their studies.

For each level (A1, A2, B1, and B2), candidates will undergo an examination that allows them to proceed to the next level. The candidates who obtain the B2 certificate will be eligible for a **fully sponsored three-year professional training program in Germany**. This training encompasses:

- Anatomy and physiology
- Pathology
- Nursing processes and diagnostics
- Medication theory and administration
- Wound care
- Patient communication and interaction
- Legal and ethical aspects of nursing
- Practical assignments

Upon completion, a three-year work commitment in the care sector is required. Afterward, candidates may choose to continue working in Germany or return to their home countries as trained professional care workers.

Applicants should fulfill the minimum requirements below:

- Aged between 18 and 30 years
- Completed at least secondary education with eligibility for university admission
- Good health, certified by an authorized medical doctor
- Clear criminal record

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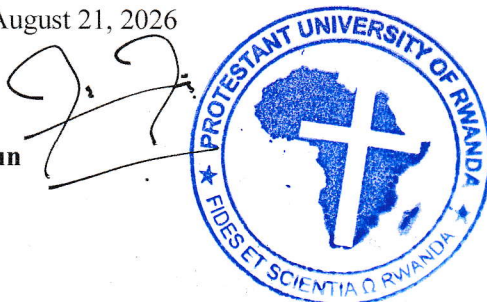

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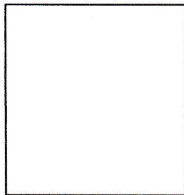
